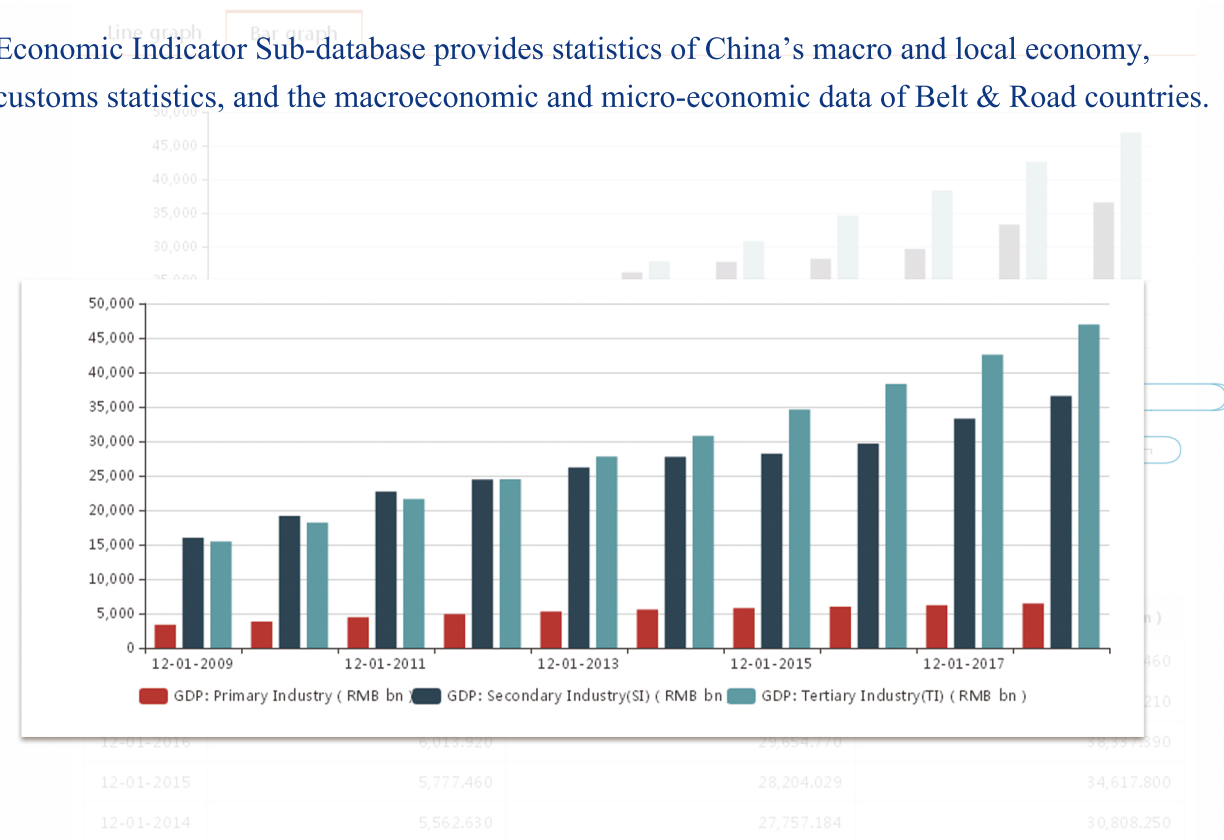
China Listed Company Sub-database

Economic Indicator Sub-database provides statistics of China's macro and local economy, customs statistics, and the macroeconomic and micro-economic data of Belt & Road countries.



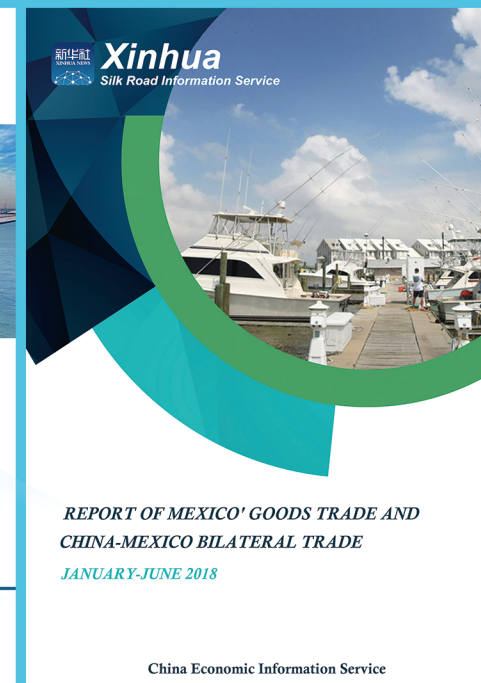
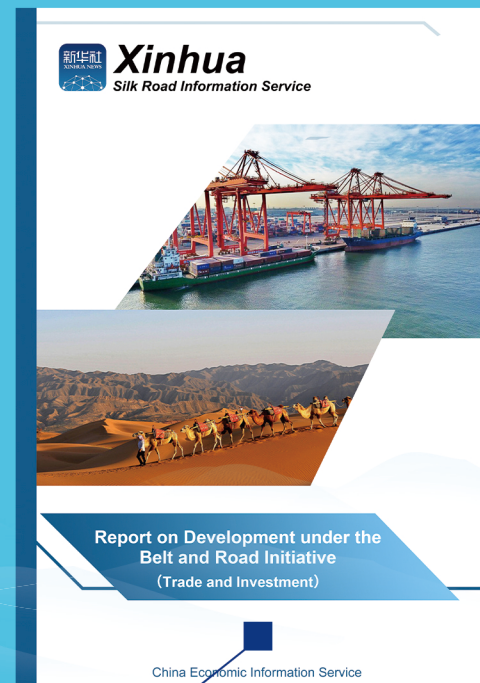
Research Report Sub-database

In addition to online services, Xinhua Silk Road provides clients with customized offline services like holding conferences and seminars at home and abroad.



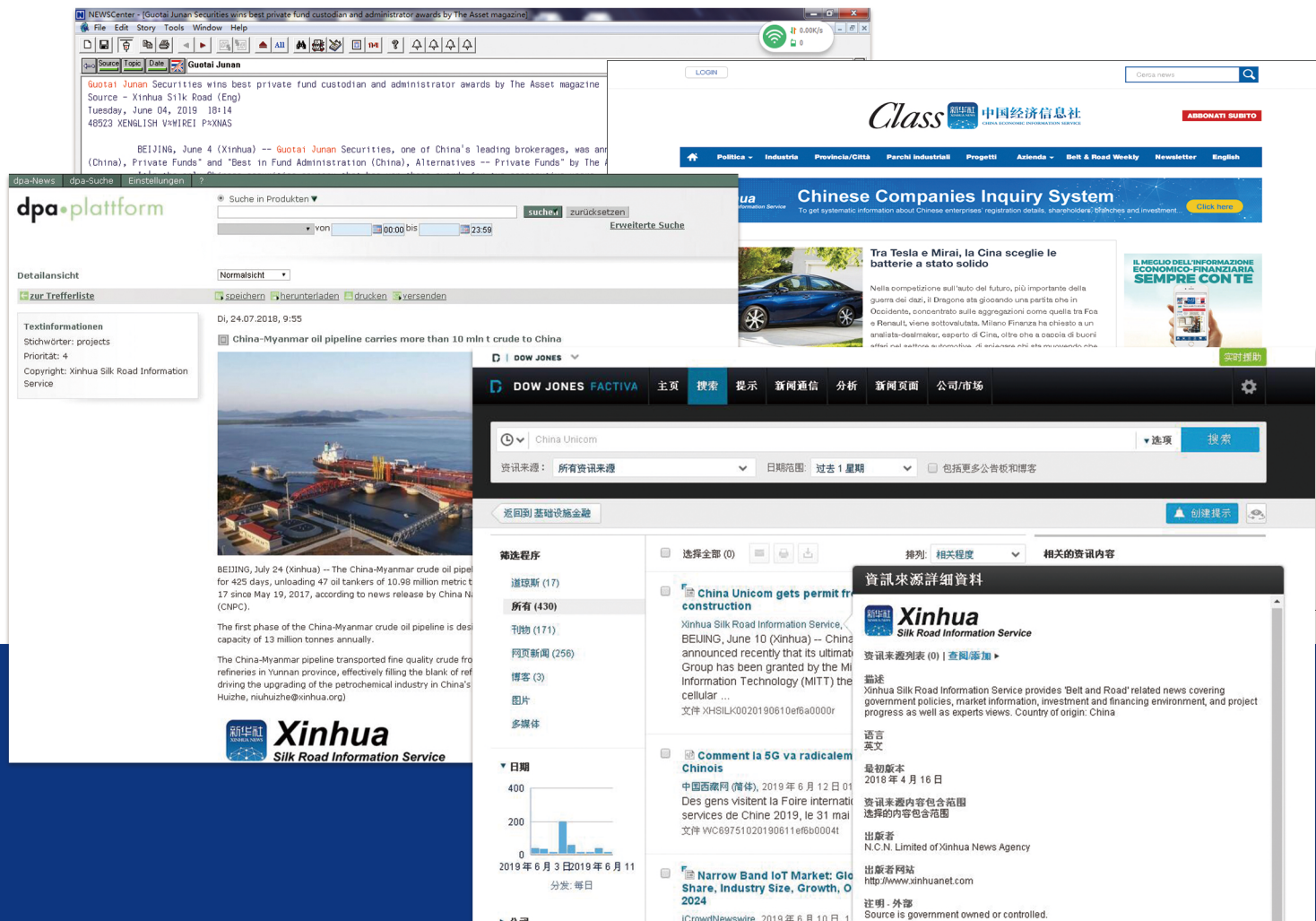

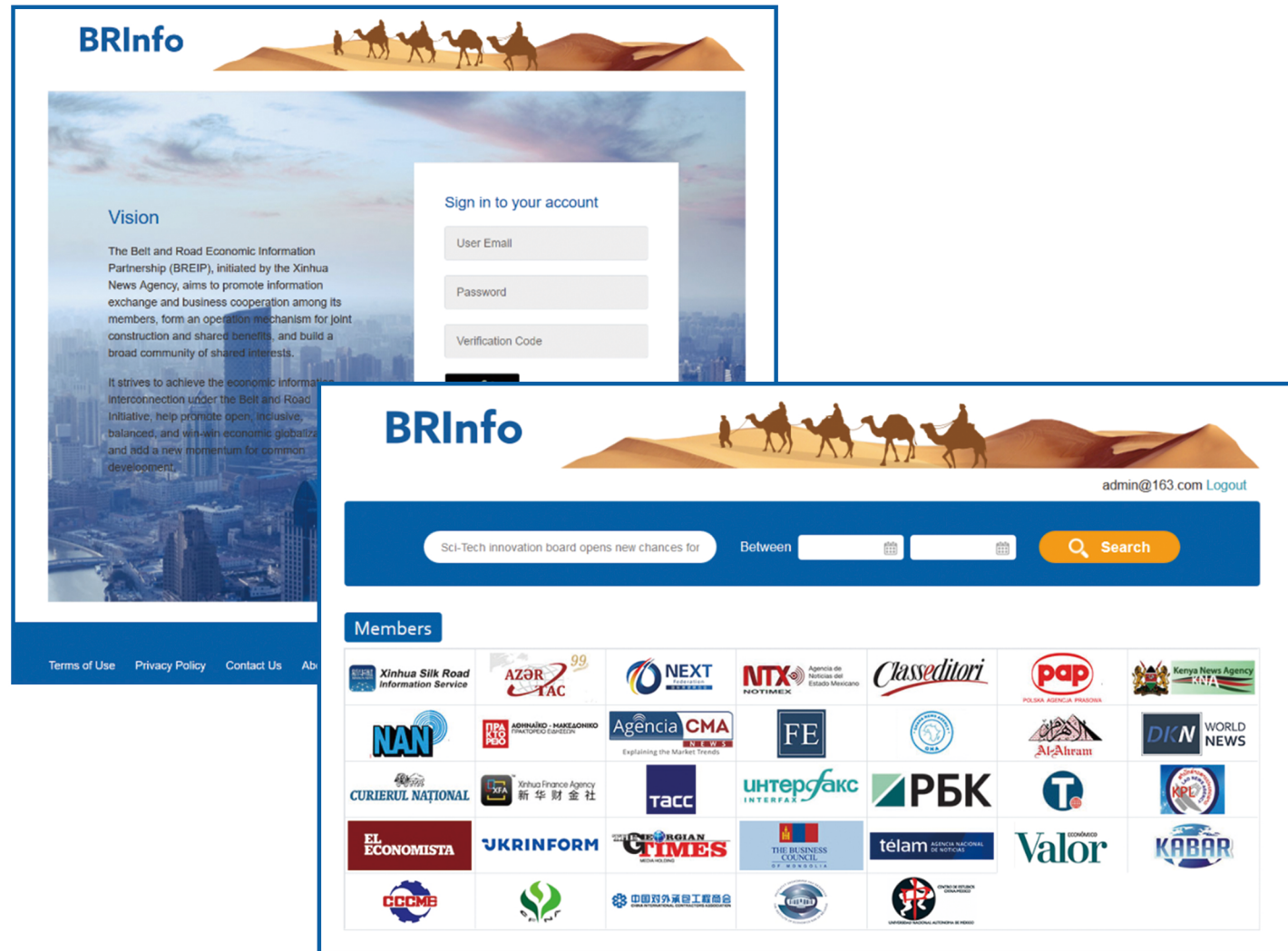
